

FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received a subgrant application for Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District- Zone 7, Alameda County, CA. Pursuant to Executive Order (EO) 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, final notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Public Assistance Grant Program (PA).

An initial disaster-wide Public Notice for DR-4699-CA was published 9/11/2023. Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions.

Under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), federal actions must be reviewed and evaluated for feasible alternatives and for social, economic, historic, environmental, legal, and safety considerations. EO 11988 and EO 11990 requires FEMA to consider alternatives and provide a public notice of any proposed actions in or affecting floodplains or wetlands. This notice may also fulfill requirements under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA).

This notice serves as a project-specific final notice for FEMA's funding action located within a Special Flood Hazard Area. FEMA has determined the only practicable alternative is to fund repairs to the Pleasanton and Arroyo de la Laguna channels embankment. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements. There is a potential for the facility to be impacted by future flooding events due to its location within the unshaded X and AE Floodway The proposed work will take place in wetlands per the United States Fish and Wildlife Service National Wetlands Inventory and will have little potential to impact or affect wetland values.

Proposed Work and Purpose: Heavy precipitation resulted in significant surface water runoff and fast flowing floodwater eroded the earthen banks of the channels maintained by the applicant. This also caused erosion slope failures in some locations. The sub applicant will repair the embankment in these location using approximately 2741 CY of earthen material. The repairs will be made to pre disaster condition and function within its original footprint. No mitigation or changes to the footprint will occur. This will aid to bring back the embankment like it was before and serve to protect the surrounding area from future flood events.

Project Alternatives:

- (1) *(No Action)* This alternative would result in risk of additional damages. If the damage is not repaired, then adverse economic and social impacts may occur and continued negative impacts may be experienced.
- (2) *(Repair with Mitigation)* Mitigation measures were not practicable due to not being requested by the sub applicant.
- (3) *(Relocation)* Floodplain avoidance by relocating the facility is not a practicable alternative as the embankment is functionally dependent on being in the floodplain to fulfill its purpose.
