SUBJECT: Sustainable Groundwater Management Update

SUMMARY:

To support the mission to “Deliver safe, reliable, efficient, and sustainable water and flood protection services,” and achieve the strategic goal D, Groundwater Management – “Manage and protect managing and protecting the Livermore Valley Groundwater Basin as the state designated Groundwater Sustainability Agency,” Zone 7 Water Agency (Zone 7) has been implementing the Alternative Groundwater Sustainability Plan for the Livermore Valley Groundwater Basin. The following are current updates:

- In 2023, Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL) received a grant funding from United States Department of Energy to conduct 3-year study (2022-2025) on groundwater recharge and groundwater dependent ecosystem in the Livermore Valley Groundwater basin.
- Zone 7 collaborated with LLNL researchers in data collection, and water quality analyses and provided peer-review.
- LLNL’s research study on the sources and travel times of groundwater recharge and groundwater dependent ecosystems in the Livermore Valley Basin was completed in 2025.
- In this meeting, the researchers from LLNL will present the findings of the study.
