AGENCY DESCRIPTION



Zone 7 supplies treated drinking water to retailers serving over a quarter million people in the Tri-Valley area including the cities of Pleasanton, Livermore, Dublin and, through special agreement with the Dublin San Ramon Services District, to the Dougherty Valley area. Additionally, we supply untreated water directly to agricultural businesses for irrigation of 3,500 acres, primarily South Livermore Valley vineyards. We also maintain 37 miles of local flood-protection channels; about a third of all the Valley’s channels and creeks.





POSITION DESCRIPTION



This full-time paid summer intern assignment, approximately late May to mid-to-late September depending on the school schedule, will support the agency's Water Quality Engineering section by assisting with projects and tasks such as:

- Conduct water quality studies and conducting water quality analyses
- Evaluate treatment performance and analyzing data
- Manage databases and maintaining records
- Prepare documents such as drawings, reports, technical memorandums, and standard operating procedures

Clear training and objectives will be provided to develop skills for potential career opportunities in the water utility industry. Interns will gain valuable knowledge and practical experience in drinking water regulations and compliance; water quality regulations and compliance; water treatment processes and performance evaluation; data analysis and database management; technical writing and documentation; and more



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS
