AGENCY DESCRIPTION

Zone 7 supplies treated drinking water to retailers serving over a quarter million people in the Tri-Valley area including the cities of Pleasanton, Livermore, Dublin and, through special agreement with the Dublin San Ramon Services District, to the Dougherty Valley area. Additionally, we supply untreated water directly to agricultural businesses for irrigation of 3,500 acres, primarily South Livermore Valley vineyards. We also maintain 37 miles of local flood-protection channels; about a third of all the Valley’s channels and creeks.





POSITION DESCRIPTION

This full-time paid summer intern assignment, approximately late May to mid-to-late September depending on the school schedule will support the agency's Water Supply Engineering section by assisting with projects and tasks such as:

- Prepare and manage consultant and construction contracts
- Manage project budgets
- Prepare and review plans, specifications and other documents related to construction contracts
- Support the development referral program
- Support the asset management and capital improvement programs

Clear training and objectives will be provided to help develop skills for potential career opportunities in the water utility industry. You will gain valuable experience by learning about the water treatment process; the operation of drinking water production and treatment facilities; performing inspections; understanding water system and construction project regulations; preparing construction plans and specifications; asset management; capital improvement planning, and more!



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Current enrollment or recent graduation (within last year) from a college or university, and successful completion of the equivalent of 30 semester (45 quarter) units of classwork
